## Triathlon - Friday 6th March

The annual Triathlon will be held on Friday the 6th of March this year. We will begin at 9:30am with the Junior Biathlon event (running & swimming), beginning with 5 year old girls, followed by 5 year old boys, 6 year old girls and 6 year old boys. This will be followed by the Junior Triathlon event (biking, running & swimming) in the same age categories.

From 11:20am the Triathlon events will take place for 7 to 10 year olds, beginning with 7 year old girls, followed by the boys etc. At this age, the children are encouraged to complete a full triathlon. If children do not bring a bike, they will take part in the running and swimming legs of the event, however they will not receive a placing.

Could children please start bringing their bikes to school from Wednesday the 4th of March. These will be locked up in our swimming pool area. We will have Simon from Project Energise coming in on Thursday the 5th to run a Bikewise programme which includes checking bikes and taking the children through a safety course. Bikes need to be at school by the 5th to ensure they have been checked. Of course all children will also need a helmet.

Please remember to collect bikes once the Triathlon has concluded or they will be locked in the pool area over the weekend.

As always we love to have family and friends coming along to support the children.

Prizegiving for the event will be held at our morning assembly on Friday the 13th March.
