Kia ora koutou

Further to the message in last week's newsletter regarding the closure of the south end of Wira Street for the ongoing stormwater maintenance works, I can now confirm the following:

- The south end (Mahi Road end) of Wira Street will be closed from approximately 7am tomorrow morning - Tuesday 23rd May, until Wednesday 7th June.
- During this time the road will become a 2-way street to allow residents to access their properties.
- Due to the street becoming 2-way there is **NO parking permitted in Wira Street**, except in the 10 parking bays in front of the school.

This has implications for us here at school and we ask for your co-operation with the following:

- Our buses will drop off and pick up the children from Mahi Road, by our lower playing field. A temporary bus bay will be signposted and we ask everyone to refrain from parking in it.
- The only access into and out of Wira Street will be via the northern end (Waeranga Road end) which means vehicles will need to turn around in quite limited space on the street.

For safety reasons we need everyone to adhere to the NO Parking rule that will be in place when coming to the school especially between 8.30 and 9.00am; and 2.40 and 3.00pm as our children are arriving and leaving school. As previously mentioned we appreciate there will be some inconvenience to you all as you will need to park slightly further from the school and walk to drop off and collect your children.

Thank you everyone for your patience and co-operation over the next couple of weeks. As a school we are also bound by the rules that have been put in place for the contractors and the temporary transport plan that will operate.
